Data Protection Policy (2026 Update)

Introduction & Special Category Data

Oxton HC is a Community Amateur Sports Club (CASC) committed to protecting the privacy of members. We process "Special Category Data," including medical conditions and disability information, solely to ensure player safety and meet equity requirements.

Lawful Basis for Processing

- **Contractual:** To manage memberships, subscriptions, and league registrations.
- **Legal Obligation:** To satisfy safeguarding and DBS requirements for those working with minors.
- **Legitimate Interests:** To organize fixtures, team selection via Spond, and communicate club news.

International Data Transfers & Cloud Storage

The Club uses cloud-based semi-automated systems (e.g., Google Workspace, and England Hockey's GMS) to store membership data and coordinate club activities."

Some of these providers may host data on servers located outside the UK (e.g., in the US). Where this occurs, we ensure that the provider is a signatory to the UK Extension to the Data Privacy Framework or uses Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the ICO to ensure your data receives the same level of protection as it would within the UK.

Media & Photography Compliance

In accordance with England Hockey guidance, we require written consent from both the young person and their parent/guardian before publishing images. Identifiable images of minors will be deleted after 24 months once the "need has been fulfilled".

Your Rights

Members have the right to access their data, request deletion ("Right to be Forgotten"), or object to processing for marketing. Withdrawal of consent for photography can be made at any time by contacting the Club Secretary.
